Cameron Ward, an international guitarist and musician born and bred in Lotus River, Cape Flats was mentioned by South African Legend Masekela as "one of his favorite musicians". Ward was a member of Masekela's band since the age of 21, his sound influenced by cape favorites George Benson, Jonathan Butler, and Jimmy Dudu. As a child, Ward says his mother shielded him from the street gangs with church and music, -by playing the drums in church and then being sent to music school by his mother to study piano.

Cameron Ward has headlined with Masekela at such venues as Carnegie Hall in New York, Yoshi's Jazz Club in Oakland, and The Hollywood Bowl in Los Angeles. Internationally, Ward has played in countless venues across Africa, and crisscrossed Europe, playing the Lugano Music Festival in Switzerland, the North Sea Jazz Festival in the Netherlands, the Montreal Jazz Festival, the Back to Black Jazz Festivals in London and Brazil, the famed Ronnie Scott's Jazz Club in London and the Blue Note Jazz Club in Tokyo, Japan.

CELEBRATING 50 YEARS IN MINISTRY


Prof Dr. Rev Allen Aubrey Boesak, born 2


Travelling the world is high on his list as he hopes to tour the countries where it sells the most.
