Learners will return to the classroom on 18 January 2022.

The province's Education MEC David Maynier said: "Schools close today, we can reflect on the many wonderful highlights in the education sector this year from the stellar performance by our teachers at the National Teachers Awards to the international recognition the two of our schools - as finalists received in the World Best School..." Maynier said pupils also achieved on the international stage from science fairs to tourism competitions.



THOUSANDS HIT BY FLOODS ACROSS WESTERN CAPE WITH MORE DOWNPOURS PREDICTED THIS WEEKEND

Thousands of people around the country have been affected by floods after heavy rains washed away homes and infrastructure.

Scientists warn that these extreme weather events are likely to become more frequent and more intense as a result of climate change. Colin Deiner, Chief Director of Disaster Management and Fire & Rescue Services said: Monday, the Western Cape experienced intense weather conditions including torrential rain, that lead to flooding, specifically in the Paarl/Wellington area. "Monday's rainfall for Paarl (40mm in 24hr period) was a record for December since the opening of the station in 1993. The previous record was 35mm in December 2002," according to forecaster Kate Turner.

Christmas is a week away and the preparations have already started. With schools being closed it means that the kids can help with chores around the house and help with the prep work for Christmas lunch.

Prices of groceries have soared over the past few weeks due to petrol hikes so careful planning for that special lunch on Christmas day is important. I would suggest a whole chicken roast with colourful vegetables.

You could as well add a buttery bowl of mash potatoes and a drizzle of your favourite sauce. This is my special recipe for a roast chicken.



Recipe: 1 whole chicken cleaned and washed

Marinade 1 tbsp olive oil 1 tbsp paprika 2 teaspoons mixed herbs 2 tbsp Mrs Ball chutney in hot Lemon juice

Mix all together and rub on the chicken. Cover and leave for 30 minutes Set oven to 180 degrees. Place chicken on an oven tray. Add cleaned and cut mixed vegetables around the chicken. Place sprigs of rosemary and thyme in the tray. This will add flavour to the chicken. Add salt and pepper on the vegetables.

Bake for 20 minutes until chicken and vegetables are cooked. Then put oven on grill and brown chicken for 3 minutes on each side. Remove from oven, cool and serve.

This is the quickest and easiest recipe. Roast chicken can be prepared in advance and refrigerated until needed. I would like to wish you and your families a Merry Christmas and a Prosperous New Year.

FRANCE AND ARGENTINA TO BATTLE IT OUT FOR WORLD CUP GLORY

The World Cup final is set. Argentina vs France will see PSG teammates Lionel Messi and Kylian Mbappé fight for the sport's biggest prize.

The match, at the Lusail Stadium, takes place in the early hours of Monday morning in the eastern states, and late Sunday night in the west.

Who is in the World Cup final? Argentina will meet France in the World Cup final. France are the reigning world champions, having beaten Croatia 4-2 in Russia four years ago. As such, France are looking to become just the third team to win back-to-back finals after Italy (1934 and 1938) and Brazil (1958 and 1962).

Argentina are the reigning South American champions, having won the 2021 Copa América with a 1-0 victory over Brazil at the Maracanã.

That was Argentina's first Copa América victory since 1993 and a real monkey off their backs, given it was La Albiceleste's first major title with Lionel Messi in the team.

FIFA WORLD CUP Qrt_ar2022 The two sides have played 12 times in total, with Argentina winning six, France three, with three stalemates. The two teams have met three times in World Cup matches.

Argentina won the first encounter 1-0 at the 1930 tournament, and the second 2-1 in 1978.

However, in the only knockout match between the two teams, France won 4-3 in a thriller to progress to the quarterfinals in Russia.

KURT-LEE ARENDSE UP FOR PRESTIGIOUS SA RUGBY POTY AWARD



Bulls and Springbok sensation Kurt-Lee Arendse will go up against a daunting group of national veterans for the SA Rugby Player of the Year award in a development that illustrates just how the former Blitzboks star has taken the 15-man format by storm.

SA Rugby on Wednesday announced the respective nominations for its annual awards in nine categories, with the winners being announced early next year.

Arendse's exploits are in contrast to the enduring excellence of Siya Kolisi, Lukhanyo Am, Eben Etzebeth and Frans Malherbe. Arendse made a stunning Test debut by scoring a try against the All Blacks in Mbombela, but then also received a four-week suspension for a dangerous tackle in the same game.

The 26-year-old continued his hot-stepping form on the end-of-year tour and the Bulls, and is pushing hard for a permanent starting berth ahead of Makazole Mapimpi.

The Young Player of the Year gong will also be hotly contested, with Bok scrumhalf Jaden Hendrikse perhaps the favourite – although No 8 Evan Roos, Junior Springbok captain Sacha Feinberg-Mngomezulu and Canan Moodie are real contenders too.
